lampshades patterns emphasize beaded edgings and trims as opposed to heavy solid beaded fabric motifs found in other beaded embroidery books using nothing more than embroidery threads and simple beads bead embroidery stitch samples offers beginner and advanced embroidery enthusiasts alike new ways to set their work apart
